

RULES OF CONDUCT DURING THE TESTS

- Students are not permitted to use mobile phones, smartphones, smartwatches, tablets, computers and any IT or communication tool suitable for storing and transmitting and receiving information. In addiction, students are not permitted to consult books, dictionaries and notes, unless otherwise indicated.
- Should the student be found in possession of any of the above, the test will be suspended and the student will be asked to leave the test station. Exclusion is ordered by those who are in charge of carrying out the surveillance service.
- The above-mentioned items, which may be in the student's possession, must be left in the lockers provided before the start of the test.
- Students may not confer with each other, nor communicate in any way with strangers. Should the student contravenes the above, the test will be suspended and the student will be asked to leave the test station.
- The personnel in charge of surveillance are called and authorized to carry out the operations of control, to ensure the correct conduct of the test If the student does not allow such control operations, the personnel in charge of surveillance will order the interruption of the test.
- During the test, it is not allowed to get up from the test station, nor consume food, while it is allowed to have a bottle of water.
